Answer: 26 December

Boxing Day is observed on 26 December.

Which plant is traditionally associated with kissing at Christmas?

Answer: Mistletoe

Mistletoe is traditionally hung as a Christmas decoration.

Which Charles Dickens novella features Ebenezer Scrooge?

Answer: A Christmas Carol

Ebenezer Scrooge is the central character in A Christmas Carol.

Which country gives the Christmas tree in Trafalgar Square to London each year?

Answer: Norway

Norway gives the tree as thanks for British support during the Second World War.

Which monarch gave the first televised Royal Christmas Message?

Answer: Queen Elizabeth II

Queen Elizabeth II delivered the first televised Royal Christmas Message in 1957.

In the song The Twelve Days of Christmas, what is given on the fifth day?

Answer: Five gold rings

The fifth gift is five gold rings.

What name is often given to the comic female role in a British pantomime?

Answer: The dame

The pantomime dame is a traditional comic role.

The Feast of Stephen falls on the same date as which UK public holiday?

Answer: Boxing Day

The Feast of Stephen is observed on 26 December, the same date as Boxing Day.

Which green, red-berried plant is commonly used in Christmas wreaths and decorations?

Answer: Holly

Holly is a traditional Christmas decoration.
