Answer: Wembley Stadium

Wembley is England's national stadium and a regular venue for major finals.

Which football club is nicknamed the Gunners?

Answer: Arsenal

Arsenal's nickname comes from the club's origins with workers at the Royal Arsenal.

3

Which city are Celtic and Rangers both based in?

Answer: Glasgow

Celtic and Rangers are Glasgow clubs and rivals in the Old Firm fixture.

4

Which England goalkeeper was part of the 1966 World Cup-winning team?

Answer: Gordon Banks

Gordon Banks played in goal for England during the 1966 World Cup final.

5

Which club plays its home matches at Anfield?

Answer: Liverpool

Anfield has been Liverpool's home ground since the club was founded.

6

Which Premier League club is nicknamed the Toffees?

Answer: Everton

Everton are widely known as the Toffees.

In football, what is a hat-trick?

Answer: Three goals scored by the same player in one match

The term is used across sports, but in football it means one player scores three goals.

Which country did England beat in the 1966 FIFA World Cup final?

Answer: West Germany

England beat West Germany 4-2 after extra time at Wembley.

Which club is associated with the song You'll Never Walk Alone?

Answer: Liverpool

The song is strongly associated with Liverpool supporters at Anfield.

What colour shirts do Newcastle United traditionally wear?

Answer: Black and white stripes

Newcastle United are famous for black and white striped home shirts.
